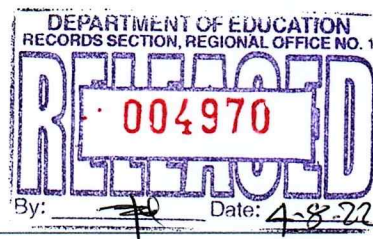

**SUBMISSION OF RE-ENTRY APPLICATION PROJECT (REAP) FROM THE ALUMNI OF THE KOREA-PHILIPPINES TEACHER EXCHANGE PROGRAM (KPTEP) FROM BATCHES 2012-2021**

- The Department of Education through the International Cooperation Office (ICO) announces the invitation of the Korea-Philippines Teacher Exchange Program (KPTEP) for submission of the Re-Entry Application Project (REAP) from the KPTEP Alumni from batches 2012-2021.
- The KPTEP is developed as part of the Asia-Pacific Teacher Exchange (APTE) for global citizenship which aims to enhance teachers' global competencies, intercultural literacy, and mutual understandings across different cultures.
- The KPTEP also provides opportunity for the participants to present the REAP, which is an innovative project that applies the concepts of Global Citizen Education (GCED) to address identified priority improvement areas as included in the School Improvement Plan (SIP).
- In line with this, the Schools Division Offices are requested to facilitate the REAP submission of the KPTEP Alumni (Batches 2012-2021). The ICO will determine the 10 Best REAP Project Implementer to present during the awarding ceremony.
- The criteria in selecting the REAP is listed below for reference:

CRITERIA	DETAILS
1. Effectiveness	Effectiveness is met as evidenced by the accomplishments of the GCED competencies of the beneficiaries as seen from the results and contribution in the attainment of SDG Goal Numbers 4 and 4.7.
2. Efficiency of Implementation	The target milestones as identified in the proposal were achieved, applied, and cost-saving measures or other innovative ways in using material resources without sacrificing the quality of outputs

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


3. Application of Learning	The identified gap challenges or problems aligned with the Global Citizenship Education (GCED) themes and thrust can anchor the Application Project in addressing any priority areas of the school/division as stated in the SIP or DEDP
4. Replicability	The results of the Project can be shared with other teachers for replication with GCED School Communities.
