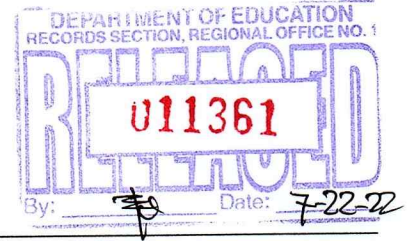

ANO ANG KUWENTONG QUEZON MO?

(A sequel to PROJECT KKK-R1, EDGE 2 : KUWENTONG BAYANI, GABAY NG LAHI)

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. Pursuant to the Philippine Constitution specifically Article XIV, Section 3, stating our vital role in inculcating patriotism, nationalism, and appreciation of the role of national heroes in the historical development of the country, and in response to the perceptible need to rekindle the ideals of freedom, nationalism, and patriotism among all our stakeholders, a series of search for life's lesson learned from the national and local heroes tagged as "**ANO ANG KUWENTONG BAYANI MO?**" is hereby proffered to all schools division offices and instrumentalities of DepEd Region I.
2. The search is an initiative of DepEd Region 1 through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) Araling Panlipunan Area. It is a sequel to the curricular interventions addressing the teaching and learning gaps in Philippine History & Studies named as **PROJECT KUWENTONG KASAYSAYAN AT KULTURATUNGO SA KALINANGANG REHIYON UNO (Project KKK-R1), EDGE 2 : KUWENTONG BAYANI, GABAY NG LAHI** specifically on the recognition and appreciation of heroic deeds & aspirations, sense of nationhood, and patriotism.
3. Honoring Quezon in time with the celebration of the Buwan ng Pambansang Wika, and at the same time the History Month and the founding month of ASEAN in the month of August, the search on "**ANO ANG KUWENTONG QUEZON MO?**" will be one of the highlights of the commemorations. This intends to a) acknowledge Quezon as a national hero and patriot, his sense of nationhood, aspirations, and struggles for the nation's freedom, b) highlight the lessons learned from him that contributed to the quality of life and destiny of the nation, and c) revisit the historical accounts of Manuel Luis Quezon.
4. The search is open to all teaching and non-teaching staff, parents and other DepEd personnel and interested partner service providers regionwide. Entries shall be expressed through a **Spoken Poetry** with consideration of the stated description for the entries.

Cluster 1: Inter-FDR1 Search	One (1) select – representative per Functional Division of DepEd Region 1	The entries must relate information, insights, and views characterized by rhyme, repetition, improvisation, and wordplay or spoken word poems containing anecdotes, and influences of Manuel L. Quezon. Lessons learned from the hero by the speaker/writer may also be highlighted. The spoken word may be in a form of rap, hip-hop, storytelling, theater, jazz, rock, blues, and folk music.
