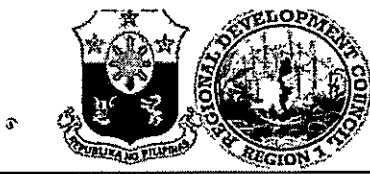

Greetings from the Regional Statistics Committee II!


