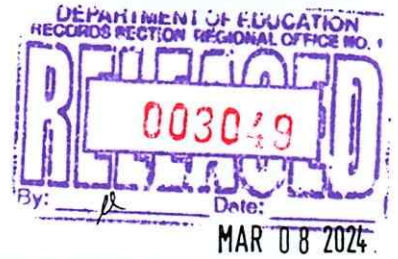

Greetings from the Regional Statistics Committee I!


