**TESTING WINDOW ADJUSTMENT FOR THE ADMINISTRATION
 OF THE NATIONAL LEARNING CAMP ASSESSMENT (NLCA) 2024 PRE-TEST**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- Per DM-CT-2024-126 dated April 22, 2024, titled, Adjustments in the Testing Window for the Administration of the National Learning Camp Assessment (NLCA) 2024, the testing window for the conduct of the NLCA for Grades 7 and 8 is reopened. On the other hand, the NLCA for Grades 9 and 10 will start on May 6 instead of May 2, to give way for the technical preparations and readiness of the test in the Moodle Learning Management System (LMS) platform.
- The re-opening of the testing window for Grades 7 and 8 shall accommodate the learners enrolled in the LMS who were not able to take the test.
- Following the provisions in the DepEd Order 37, s. 2022, titled Guidelines on the Cancellation or Suspension of Classes and Work in Schools in the Event of Natural Disasters, Power Outages/Power Interruptions and Other Calamities, the Schools Division Superintendents, in agreement with their local Chief Executives, have the prerogative to conduct the NLCA for Grades 9 and 10 beyond the given testing window within the school year, if unforeseen circumstances arise that may affect the safety and protection of the learners and personnel.

**Testing Window Adjustment for the Administration of the National Learning
Camp Assessment (NLCA) 2024 Pre-test**

1. Following the announcement in the DM-CT-2024-126 dated April 22, 2024, titled *Adjustments in the Testing Window for the Administration of the National Learning Camp Assessment (NLCA) 2024*, the testing window for the conduct of the NLCA for Grades 7 and 8 is re-opened as shown in table below. On the other hand, the NLCA for Grades 9 and 10 will start on May 6 instead of May 2, to give way for the technical preparations and readiness of the test in the Moodle Learning Management System (LMS) platform.

| Grade Level | Testing Window | Remark |
|----------------|-------------------|-----------|
| Grade 7 and 8 | May 6 to 10, 2024 | Re-opened |
| Grade 9 and 10 | May 6 to 24, 2024 | Adjusted |

2. The re-opening of the testing window for Grades 7 and 8 grants many requests from field offices to accommodate learners enrolled in the LMS but not able to take the test.
3. Following the provisions in DepEd Order 037, s. 2022, titled *Guidelines on the Cancellation or Suspension of Classes and Work in Schools in the Event of Natural Disasters, Power Outages/Power Interruptions and Other Calamities*, the Schools Division Superintendents, in agreement with their local chief executives, have the prerogative to conduct the NLCA for Grades 9 and 10 beyond the given testing window within the school year, if unforeseen circumstances arise that may affect the safety and protection of the learners and personnel.
4. During the implementation of the NLCA, testing personnel from all levels of governance (i.e., region, division, district, school) and all others concerned are enjoined to observe strict security measures to maintain the integrity of the test and its results.
