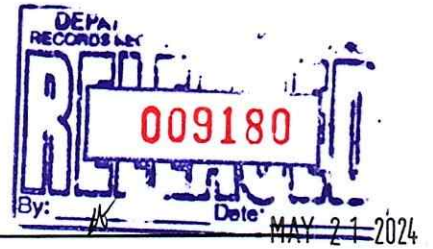

ADVISORY RE: DEPED ORDER NO. 014, S. 2023 ENTITLED POLICY GUIDELINES ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NATIONAL LEARNING CAMP (NLC) ON THE MISINTEPRETATIONS AND INCONSISTENCIES OF NLC PROVISIONS

1. This is in reference to the attached Advisory from Dir. Wilfredo E. Cabral, Director IV , Officer-In-Charge, Office of the Undersecretary for Human Resource and Organizational Development re: Policy Guidelines on the Implementation of the National Learning Camp (NLC) on the Misinterpretations And Inconsistencies of NLC Provisions.
2. In line with this, it is reiterated that the service rendered during the NLC that are earned as Vacation Service Credits (VSC) are **on top of the 15 days maximum VSC** as may allowed by applicable guidelines. Moreover, it is hereby given clarification that individual authorization and/or certification on earned VSCs by the Office of the Secretary shall no longer be necessary. VSCs earned during the conduct of NLC shall be deemed "*authorized by the Secretary*" by virtue of her approval of the said DepEd Order.

This is in reference to DepEd Order (DO) No. 014, s.2023 titled "*Policy Guidelines on the Implementation of the National Learning Camp*" dated July 03, 2023.

It has been brought to the attention of this Office and the Office of the Secretary that there have been misinterpretations and inconsistencies in the implementation of Part V(H) Item 55 of the NLC Guidelines, which states that:

"All teachers involved in these NLRP-related EOSY break activities shall be granted vacation service credits for the services rendered during the NLC. One (1) workday of vacation service credit shall be granted per accumulated eight (8) hours of service rendered, as certified by their respective SHs. The number of service credits authorized is exclusive of the fifteen (15) days maximum vacation service credits allowed as stipulated in DO 53, s. 2003 (Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers)."

As such, it is reiterated that the services rendered during the NLC that are earned as Vacation Service Credits (VSC) are **on top of the 15 days maximum VSC** as may allowed by applicable guidelines. Further, it is hereby clarified that individual authorization and/or certification of earned VSCs by the Office of the Secretary shall no longer be necessary. VSCs earned during the conduct of NLC shall be deemed "*authorized by the Secretary*" by virtue of her approval of DO 014, s. 2023.
