Security Bank Foundation, Inc. (SBFI) has been advocating for the improvement of the quality of education in the Philippines. Our flagship "Build a School, Build a Nation" program, was launched in 2011 with the aim of donating classrooms to public schools to help address classroom shortage. By the end of 2024, we would have already donated 845 classrooms in 86 cities and municipalities nationwide - 770 classrooms are in types of two-storey school buildings.

Our program was designed to be holistic with the infrastructure donation complemented with free training programs for the teachers and school principals of our beneficiary schools through our "Mentoring Future Leaders for Nation-Building" initiative.

We are currently assessing where we would prioritize our future classroom donation efforts.
