Following the recently concluded Project Pitching Exercise at the Learners' Convergence Philippines (LearnCon PH) 2024 on July 8 to 13, 2024, in Lapu-Lapu City, the Office of the Undersecretary for Operations (OUOPS) would like to once again congratulate the proponents of the Top Regional Projects who have successfully pitched their initiatives in front of the Panel of Judges and LearnCon PH 2024 participants.

To support learner-initiated community projects, all Regional Offices are requested to provide guidance and funding support to the Top Regional Projects presented at LearnCon PH 2024. This should be charged against the 2024 Program Support Funds downloaded to the Regions by the Bureau of Learner Support Services-Youth Formation Division (BLSS-YFD), following the existing accounting rules and regulations of the Department.

Indicated below are the minimum duties and responsibilities of all concerned in carrying out this initiative:

1. The concerned learners shall lead the re-development (if necessary) and implementation of the projects;
2. The concerned Division Youth Formation Coordinators shall guide the proponents in the redevelopment and implementation of the projects;
3. The Regional Federation of Supreme Secondary Learner Government shall support the proponents in the planning and implementation of the community projects of their respective regions; and



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4. The concerned Schools Division Superintendents and the Regional Youth Formation Coordinators shall supervise the funding approval, implementation, and monitoring and evaluation of the funded projects.

Lastly, all regions may consider funding support to the other projects submitted by learners for the Project Pitching Exercise but did not qualify as Top Regional Project. Should any region opt to fund these projects, please inform BLSS-YFD for our documentation.

Enclosed are (1) the list of Top Regional Projects from the LearnCon PH 2024 Project Pitching Exercise, and (2) the project proposal template.
