ON THE EARLY LANGUAGE LITERACY AND NUMERACY (ELLN)
WITH FOCUS ON THE SCIENCE OF READING- BATCH II (CLUSTER II)**


To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. The Department of Education Region I through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) will conduct the **Regional Upskilling of K to 3 Teachers and Elementary School Heads on the Early Language Literacy and Numeracy (ELLN) with Focus on the Science of Reading-Batch II (Cluster II)** on September 25-October 1, 2024 at Regency Hotel, Calasiao, Pangasinan.
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. upskill K to 3 teachers and elementary school heads capacity to use a knowledge-based pedagogy to become effective reading implementers;
 - b. enhance participants' capacity to provide technical assistance to the K to 3 teachers; and
 - c. promote and sustain a culture of reading in schools, and even in the communities.
3. The participants in the activity are K to 3 Teachers and Elementary School Heads. *Enclosure 1* lists the number of participants for each SDO and the Program Management Team/Technical Working Group. Participants and Learning Facilitators are advised to pre-register through this link <https://tinyurl.com/Ro1SORBatchII-PangasinanII> on or before September 23, 2024.
4. Board and lodging of the participants, trainers/facilitators, and members of the Program Management Team/Technical Working Group shall be charged to FY 2024 ELLN Program Support Funds downloaded to SDO Pangasinan II while travel expenses and other incidental expenses shall be charged to division/local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants are encouraged to use the most economical means of transport in going to and from the venue.
5. Participants are expected to be at the venue on Day 0 before 1:00 PM and to check-out after Lunch of Day 6. The first meal provision is Afternoon Snacks on Day 0 of September 25 and the last meal provision is Lunch of Day 6 of October 1, 2024. Sessions will start on September 25 at 1:00 PM.

6. Service credits for teaching personnel and Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) for non-teaching personnel will be granted in lieu of the workshop/training days that will fall on either holidays or weekends in accordance with the provisions of CSC and DepEd Joint Circular No.2, s. 2004, and CSC-DBM Circular No.2, s. 2015 entitled Policies and Guidelines on Overtime Services and Overtime Pay for Government Employees, respectively.
