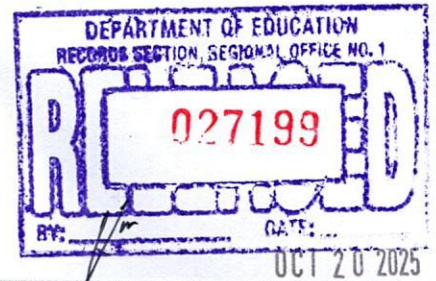

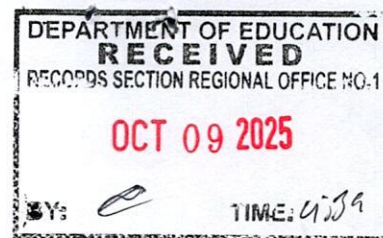

On School Verification

Khan Academy personnel will visit each identified school to validate technological readiness (internet connectivity, availability of student devices, and teacher/administrator readiness). SDO personnel (EPS, PSDS, or Division IT Officer) are requested to accompany the verification team to ensure swift and efficient validation. **Schools are not required to prepare programs, lay, or food;** the visits will last approximately for 20–30 minutes only. It is also requested that school devices be powered on during the scheduled visit to facilitate testing of internet connectivity.

All concerned Regions, SDOs, and schools are enjoined to ensure the timely submission of school nominations and to extend full support to the scheduled verification and training activities. This will ensure the smooth inclusion of additional schools and the successful rollout of Wave 2.

As part of the implementation support, the concerned Regions and SDOs are requested to provide the necessary training venue and meals for participants during the scheduled face-to-face training activities.

To ensure maximum participation, it is also requested that Compensatory Time-Off or Service Credits be granted to teachers and personnel who will attend training sessions that fall on weekends, subject to all relevant rules and regulations of the Department of Education.

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For us to facilitate these upcoming activities properly, we would like to remind the following:

On school verification:

Our Officer will go to each school in the list to validate if the schools have met the technological requirements as well as establish rapport with the personnel from the ROs, the SDOs and school heads.

In line with this, we would like to request that any personnel of the SDO (EPS, PSDS, and/or Division IT Officer) accompany us in going to the schools so that verification will be swift and more efficient. Schools need not prepare anything such as program, lay, food, etc. We only expect to stay 20-30 minutes per school where we will do the following:

May we also request that the devices (PCs, laptops, tablets, etc.) in the computer lab be turned on during the day of the visit so that when the verification team arrives, they can easily check the internet speed.

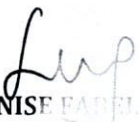
