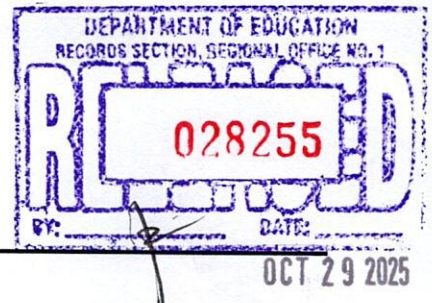

**CONDUCT OF INITIAL EVALUATION AND VALIDATION OF PROBABLE
FY 2025 NATIONAL ASSESSMENT FOR SCHOOL HEADS (NASH)
BATCH 2 EXAMINEES**

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. The FY 2025 National Assessment of School Heads (NASH) Batch 2 is tentatively scheduled on November 30, 2025 (Mock Examination) and December 7, 2025 (Actual Examination).
2. In preparation for this, all Schools Division Offices (SDOs), through the SDO Human Resource Development Section and Personnel Unit, are requested to conduct initial evaluation and validation of probable FY 2025 NASH Batch 2 examinees.
3. The target examinees for the FY 2025 NASH batch 2 are specified as follows:

Examination	Date	Target Examinees
Mock Examination	November 30, 2025	<u>Priority A</u> • Head Teachers and Assistant School Principals (regardless whether they meet the QS for School Principal I) • FY 2025 NASH Batch 1 Category C
Actual Examination	December 7, 2025	<u>Priority B</u> • FY 2023 NQESH Category B and C • FY 2021 NQESH Category C <u>Priority C</u> • Other personnel (MTs, T-III) who are qualified based on the NEW CSC-Approved QS • Other Personnel with concurrent designation as School Head who are qualified based on the NEW CSC-Approved QS

All SDOs are requested to **observe PRIORITIZATION of the target examinees** as indicated above.

4. As indicated under Priority C, the eligibility of other personnel shall be determined based on the Civil Service Commission (CSC)-approved Qualification Standards (QS) for School Heads. Under these standards, an applicant must:

- a. hold a Master's degree in Education, Educational Management, or Educational Leadership (OR a Master's in a relevant field WITH 9 units in educational management),
- b. have AT LEAST 5 years of teaching experience;
- c. possess at least one (1) year of relevant experience in coordination, supervision, or school management; AND
- d. have COMPLETED 32 hours of training in areas like curriculum, pedagogy, school management, or instructional leadership within the last five years.

5. In addition, SDOs are requested to submit to the Regional Office the most recent **number of probable examinees** through the Human Resource Development Division. Please use the attached template (*See Annex A*) and submit duly-endorsed data (in pdf) to hrdd.region1@deped.gov.ph until **November 4, 2025**.

6. Actual allotted number of examinees for each SDO and other official announcements regarding the conduct of FY 2025 NASH Batch 2 shall be communicated through a separate memorandum.
