**REGIONAL MEMORANDUM**

No. 1725 s. 2025

**LEARNER GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2026-2027**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. This pertains to **DepEd Order No. 12, s. 2025**, titled “**Multi-Year Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities,**” this Office provides guidance on the conduct of the **Learner Government Elections for School Year (SY) 2026–2027.**

2. The school-based elections for the Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG) and Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) shall take place immediately after the 3rd Quarter Examination, with a two-week period allocated for preparation, campaigning, and voting. Following these elections, another two weeks shall be designated for planning and conducting the District, Division, and Regional Federation Elections. The schedule for the National Federation of Supreme Secondary Learner Government (NFSSLG) elections shall be issued separately.

3. As part of the preparations for SY 2026-2027, the Department, through the Bureau of Learner Support Services (BLSS) and the Learner Formation Division, announces the schedule for the SELG and SSLG elections. For proper guidance and uniform implementation, the indicative schedule for the conduct of Learner Government Elections shall be as follows:

Activity	Date
School-Based Elections	January 26-February 13, 2026
District and Division Elections	February 16-March 6, 2026
Regional Federation Elections	March 9-27, 2026
National Federation Elections	To be announced in a separate Memorandum

4. The objective of this initiative is to establish learner representation at all levels of governance, from the school to the national level, through the SELG and SSLG elections for SY 2026-2027.

5. To ensure successful implementation of this program, all Schools Division Superintendent and School Heads, through their respective Youth Formation Coordinators and SELG/SSLG Advisers, are requested to provide assistance during the conduct of these activities.



7. Implementing schools are required to adhere to the prescribed guidelines but are encouraged to adapt and enhance them through formal resolutions, in accordance with the specific context and needs of the school.
