**UPDATES ON THE STATUS OF NATIONAL ASSESSMENT FOR SCHOOL HEADS
 (NASH) PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT INTERVENTION (PDI)
 PARTICIPANTS – CATEGORY B**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. In reference to DM-OULS-2026-090, titled Guidelines on the Conduct of the National Assessment for School Heads – Professional Development Intervention (NASH-PDI), the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) is hereby transmitting the **summary of results for the Phase 1** of your participants under the category Meeting PPSSH Standards in Three (3) Domains.

2. The results, which were consolidated as of June 25, 2026, can be accessed through a link that will be forwarded to the SDO Focal Persons to align with the principles, mechanisms, and standards of the **Data Privacy Act of 2012** the information contained in the link are considered confidential in nature. The results of the participants under With Developmental Areas will be uploaded in the same link when these become available.

3. The summary of results includes information on the status of participants':
- a. E-learning (*Not Started, On-going, Done*)
 - b. Attendance and evaluation in Domain-based Sessions (*Y/N*); and
 - c. Assessment (*Passed, X means no assessment; need to retake means failed at first attempt*).

4. In this regard, please be guided by the following:
- a. Participants who have successfully completed all Phase 1 requirements are eligible to immediately proceed to Phase 2.
 - b. A Certificate of Participation shall be individually issued to Phase 1 completers on or before 03 July 2026.
 - c. Participants with remarks: Incomplete Phase 1 Requirements are requested to comply with the indicated instructions and address the identified requirements until 28 June 2026.

5. The deadline shall serve as the final extension for the submission and completion of Phase 1 requirements. Failure to comply within the prescribed period shall render participants ineligible to proceed to Phase 2, and their participation in the NASH-PDI shall be considered forfeited.

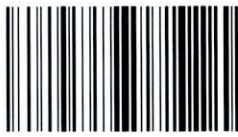

FAQS for NASH PDI PHASE 1 AND PHASE 2 REQUIREMENTS

In line with **DM-OULS-2026-090, *Guidelines on the Conduct of the National Assessment for School Heads – Professional Development Intervention (NASH-PDI)***, and the ***Advisory on NASH PDI Program Updates*** please refer to the following Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) to address common concerns pertaining to completion of Phase 1 requirements and access to Phase 2 requirements:

I. NASH PDI Phase 1 requirements

1. What are the NASH PDI Phase 1 requirements?

The NASH PDI requirements are composed of the following:

- E-learning (LinkedIn Learning Path/Alternative E-Learning Path);
- Attendance and evaluation to Domain-based sessions; and
- Passed rating in the Domain-based Assessments.

2. Where can I access the NASH PDI requirements?

3. What domains do I need to comply with?

Domains are assigned to participants under their category Meeting PPSSH in Three (3) Domains or With Developmental Areas.

4. How will I know if I have completed all the NASH PDI Phase 1 requirements?

A Summary of Results for NASH PDI Phase 1 requirements was given to RO NASH PDI focals. Participants may coordinate with respective RO/SDO focals to know the status of completion.

5. What will be my next steps if I complete Phase 1 requirements?

Participants who have successfully completed all Phase 1 requirements are eligible to immediately proceed to Phase 2. Kindly coordinate with respective Coaches or RO/SDO focal person to proceed with the Job-Embedded Learning or the Coaching and Mentoring sessions.

6. Will I receive a Certificate upon completion of Phase 1 requirements?

A **Certificate of Participation** shall be individually issued to Phase 1 completers on or before **03 July 2026**.

7. What will I do if my name has a remark of Incomplete Phase 1 requirements?

Participants with remarks of Incomplete Phase 1 Requirements are requested to comply with the indicated instructions and address the identified requirements **until 28 June 2026**.

8. What if I didn't complete the NASH PDI requirements within the deadline?

The deadline shall serve as the **final extension** for the submission and completion of Phase 1 requirements. Failure to comply within the prescribed period shall render participants **ineligible to proceed to Phase 2**, and their participation in the NASH-PDI shall be considered **forfeited**.

II. NASH PDI Phase 2 requirements

9. Who can serve as my coach?

Qualified coaches include Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDS), Education Program Supervisors (EPS), and Principals II–IV. They must have at least five years of experience as a school head and have completed NEAP coaching training or any equivalent coaching training conducted by the RO/SDO/CSC.

10. What is the recommended coach-to-participant ratio?

A 1:1 ratio is strongly encouraged to ensure focused, individualized support for leadership growth. However, if coaching capacity is limited, the SDO may adjust this ratio, provided that the assigned coach comfortably accommodates the additional coachees.

11. Where can my coach get the materials needed to help me?

A Coaching Toolkit is provided to all designated coaches through the SDO NASH focal person before Phase 2 begins. Likewise, orientations will be conducted in the CO and RO/SDO level to ensure clarity.

12. Can CID and SGOD Chiefs serve as coaches?

Yes. While the primary pool includes PSDS, EPS, and Principals II–IV, CID and SGOD Chiefs may serve as coaches only if the desired pool is exhausted and if they meet the standard qualifications, which include at least five (5) years of experience as a full-fledged school head and completion of NEAP coaching training or any equivalent coaching training provided by the SDO/RO/CSC.

III. Certification

13. What certificates will I receive?

Phase 1: A Certificate of Participation issued by NEAP CO. Phases 2 and 3: Certificates of Participation issued by the Regional Office (RO) or SDO upon validation of outputs. Program Completion: A final Certificate of Completion issued by NEAP CO.

14. When is the Certificate of Completion granted?

For those "Meeting PPSSH Strands in 3 Domains": After satisfactory completion of Phases 1 and 2. For those "With Developmental Areas": After satisfactory completion of Phases 1, 2, and 3, including final SDS certification of the WAAR.
