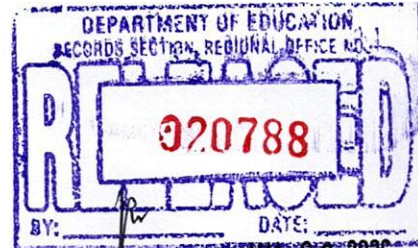

5. They shall bring their laptop computers and Wi-Fi modems for use during the workshop sessions. The participants shall bring relevant reference materials on the West Philippine Sea and ASEAN-UNESCO critical content, as well as the Araling Panlipunan Three-Term Budget of Work. Meanwhile, ADM/FLP Focal Persons shall bring their respective FLP dashboards, including the latest implementation data and targets for the current school year.

6. The first meal to be served shall be afternoon snacks on Day 1, while the last meal shall be lunch on Day 2. Board and lodging expenses shall be charged against OSEC-1-25-00850 and the FY 2025 GAA (FLO-ADM), while the travel expenses of the participants shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
