To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. Relative to the request of the Philippine Public School Teachers Association (PPSTA), this Office authorizes the conduct of PPSTA Membership Campaigns and Information Drives in public schools across Region I.
2. 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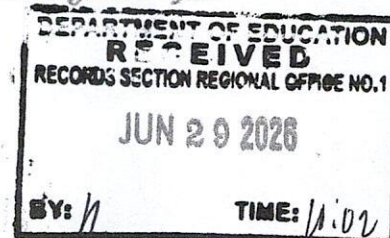
