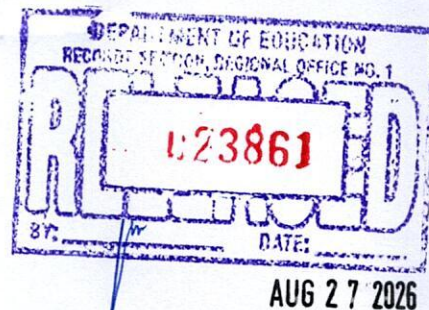

**RESCHEDULING OF THE NATIONAL TRAINING AND ORIENTATION FOR
FIELD-TESTING PERSONNEL ON THE ADMINISTRATION OF VARIOUS
ASSESSMENT PROGRAMS FOR SCHOOL YEAR (SY) 2026-2027 - LUZON
CLUSTER**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. The Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA), through its Advisory issued on August 17, 2026, announced the rescheduling of the National Training and Orientation for Field-Testing Personnel on the Administration of Various Assessment Programs for School Year (SY) 2026-2027 - Luzon Cluster, originally scheduled on August 18-20, 2026 at the Baguio Teachers Camp (BTC), to a later date due to prevailing weather conditions and in consideration of the safety of all participants.

In view of the postponement, the participants who already traveled at the venue prior to the cancellation of the activity are advised to submit pertinent financial documents to their respective offices for evaluation and processing of applicable reimbursement or liquidation of authorized travel expenses, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

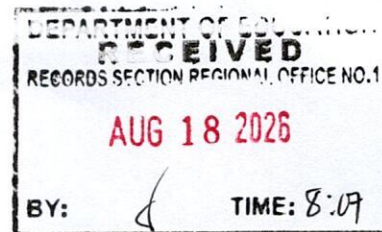

**Rescheduling of the National Training and Orientation for Field-Testing Personnel
on the Administration of Various Assessment Programs for
School Year (SY) 2026-2027 – LUZON CLUSTER**

1. In view of the *Memorandum Circular No. 128 s. 2026* announcing the work-from-home arrangements of government offices in various parts of Luzon on August 18, 2026 due continuous heavy rainfall, the **National Training and Orientation for Field-Testing Personnel on the Administration of Various Assessment Programs for School Year (SY) 2026-2027 - LUZON CLUSTER** scheduled on **August 18-20, 2026** at the **Baguio Teachers Camp (BTC)**, shall be **RESCHEDULED TO A LATER DATE**, for the participants' safety amid the intermittent weather conditions.

2. Participants are advised to observe the following important instructions:

a. For participants already at BTC

Participants who are already at BTC are advised to remain at the venue and prioritize their safety. They may proceed home only when weather and travel conditions improve, and it is safe to do so.

Keep all original or electronic travel documents, including plane/bus tickets, boarding passes, receipts, and Reimbursement Expense Receipts (RERs). A Certificate of Appearance/Attendance should also be requested from BTC before leaving the venue.

b. For participants who have already traveled but are unable to proceed to BTC

Participants who are already on their way but are unable to proceed to BTC due to the rescheduling of the training are advised to prioritize their safety and proceed to a safe location or return home when conditions permit.

Secure all tickets, boarding passes, receipts, and other proof of travel and expenses incurred, together with the appropriate documentation on the change in schedule.

c. For participants who have not yet traveled

Participants who have not yet commenced their travel are advised to defer their trip.

Those who have already booked and paid for transportation are advised to coordinate directly with the airline or bus company regarding available refund or travel credit options, as applicable. Secure documentation of any non-refundable travel expenses.

3. All pertinent financial documents shall be submitted to the participants' respective offices for evaluation and processing of applicable reimbursement or liquidation of authorized travel expenses, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
4. All participants are advised to prioritize their safety and exercise appropriate caution. The Bureau will continue to monitor the weather conditions and provide updates regarding the new training schedule and other necessary arrangements in a separate issuance. The Bureau appreciates your understanding, cooperation, and patience.
