**NEW LEARNING MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FOR THE INDUCTION PROGRAM
FOR BEGINNING TEACHERS (IPBT)**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. In reference to DM-OUHROD-2023-1372, titled "*Conduct of Activities Related to the Induction Program for Beginning Teachers (IPBT)*," dated September 20, 2023, the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) informs the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) that the **new Learning Management System (LMS) for the Induction Program for Beginning Teachers (IPBT)** may now be accessed through the link and QR code provided below.

2. Before accessing the course, all newly hired teachers are requested to register using their official DepEd email address. This will ensure proper enrollment and tracking participation in the IPBT.

3. Please be advised that this is a new LMS platform. Since progress and completion records from the previous LMS will not be migrated, all newly hired teachers will initially be enrolled in Coursebook 1.

4. To facilitate a smooth transition, SDOs, through the SGOD HRDS SEPS and EPS II, shall track and validate records of newly hired teachers covered by the IPBT from SY 2023–2024 onward and encode and submit a duly validated list of newly hired teachers who have already started the IPBT using the previous LMS. The list shall indicate the coursebook/s they have completed (e.g., Coursebook 1, Coursebook 2) and shall be submitted through the following link: <https://tinyurl.com/yj46cjr5> on or before October 1, 2026.



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5. The SGOD HRDS SEPS and EPS II are requested to coordinate with the Personnel Unit to obtain the list of newly hired teachers, continue monitoring the implementation of the Induction Program for Beginning Teachers (IPBT), and ensure the timely accomplishment and submission of the monitoring forms through the following link: <https://bit.ly/neapteacherinduction>.
